

## DECLARATION ON GRANTING CONSENT TO THE PROCESSING OF PERSONAL DATA

I, signed hereunder, grant my consent to the processing of my personal data (including data contained in the translated confirmation/certificate of vaccination outside the country) by ....., with its registered office in ....., for the purposes of entering COVID-19 vaccination I received outside the country, into the e-Zdrowie (P1)<sup>1</sup> national system. Consequently, I grant my consent to the automatic generation of the EU digital COVID<sup>2</sup> certificate after I complete the full vaccination cycle.<sup>3</sup>

At the same time, I declare that I was notified of the right to withdraw consent to the processing of my personal data at any time.

## **Information on the processing of personal data in relation to the process of issuing the EU digital COVID certificate**

In relation to fulfilment of the requirements of Article 13 of the GDPR,<sup>4</sup> we would like to inform you about the personal data processing principles and related rights.

- 1) The Controller of your personal data is ....., with its registered office in ....., ul. .... You can contact the Controller by post or email: .....
- 2) The Controller has designated a Data Protection Officer (DPO), who can be contacted by email, at ....., or by letter to the address of the registered office. The Data Processing Officer can be contacted in all matters related to the processing of personal data and exercising the rights related to the processing of data.
- 3) Your personal data are processed for the purposes of issuing an EU digital COVID certificate.<sup>5</sup>
- 4) The legal basis for the processing of personal data related to you is point (a) of Article 6(1) and point (a) of Article 9(2) of the GDPR in relation to the granted consent to the processing of personal data for the purposes specified in point 3.
- 5) Your personal data may be made available only to entities that are entitled to receive these data based on legal regulations or to entities entrusted with the processing of personal data by the Controller based on the agreement concluded. Your personal data will be entered into the e-Zdrowie (P1) national system referred to in Article 7 of the Act of 28 April 2011 on the health care information system (Journal of Laws of 2021, item 666, as amended.).
- 6) Your personal data will not be subject to automatic processing, and will not be subject to automated decision-making, including profiling.
- 7) In relation to the process of issuing the EU digital COVID certificate, normal personal data and special categories of personal data are processed, including data concerning health contained in the translated vaccination certificate in accordance with the template binding in the country of receiving the vaccine.
- 8) Your personal data will not be transferred to any third countries or international organisations.

9) Your data will be stored for the period necessary to achieve the processing objectives.

10) You have the following rights:

- right to access your data;
- right to rectify (correct) your data;
- right to request restriction of processing of data;
- right to personal data portability (if available in the particular case);
- right to object to processing of personal data;
- right to erasure of Data;
- right to withdraw consent to the processing of data at any time; this shall not affect the lawfulness of processing based on consent before its withdrawal.

11) In the case of concluding that the processing of data breaches provisions of the law, you shall have the right to lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority, i.e. the President of the Personal Data Protection Office (address: ul. Stawki 2, 00-193 Warszawa).

12) Personal data shall be provided voluntarily, but it shall be necessary to issue the EU digital COVID certificate.
